We Asked. You Spoke. We Listened.

A recent column invited the community to access the Desert Sands Unified School District web site to learn more about LCAP (Local Control Accountability Plan). Many visited our online survey or attended one of 50 stakeholder forums.

Three goals were adopted to guide spending decisions: 1) All students will demonstrate growth as measured by state/federal assessments; 2) All students will graduate and be prepared to make a successful transition to further education and/or career opportunities; 3) All students will develop and consistently demonstrate responsible, respectful, and ethical behavior in a safe, clean, and orderly learning environment. The results of each goal will be monitored, with results shared back to the community.

In June, the DSUSD Board of Education approved these initiatives.

A commitment to continue reducing class size. Kindergarten through third grade levels are progressing toward an average of 24 students per classroom. The district's new full-day kindergarten program, piloted at eight schools, will average 24 students per classroom. Grades 4-8 are projected to average 29 students per class and 30.5 students in grades 9-12.

A commitment to encourage and support teacher leadership. We are blessed with talented and dedicated teachers who are essential to our improvement efforts. Teacher on Special Assignment (TOSA) positions will facilitate the delivery of essential programs and services, including instructional coaching, English language learners, Next Generation science standards, special education, PAR/BTSA program (beginning teacher support), attendance recovery, and counselors for student assistance programs.

A commitment to use technology to create relevant learning environments and build digital literacy. A task force

will develop, implement, and monitor a plan to increase technology tools while introducing a system of site-based technician support.

A commitment to provide cuttingedge, rigorous, and relevant career/ technical education (CTE) to prepare youths for a wide range of high-wage, high-skill, high-demand careers. Five full-time educators will be assigned to serve as high school Career Technical Education (CTE) assistant principals. In addition, \$300,000 has been set aside to support career/technical education. New academies/pathways include aviation, information technology, and environmental engineering.

A commitment to keep students safe and schools secure. Assistant principal positions will be introduced at elementary schools with high numbers of students. Five attendance facilitators will support student achievement and well-being through increased attendance and reduced absenteeism/truancy.

A commitment to "grow" what is working well in DSUSD. Increased levels of financial support will go to programs such as the California College Guidance Initiative (CCGI), Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID), Advanced Placement (AP), and International Baccalaureate (IB).

A commitment to improve special education services for students with disabilities. Nine additional teachers will reduce caseloads, para-educator hours will be increased, additional professional development opportunities supported, and more dedicated and responsive administrative oversight committed. 





Keeping Animals Cool

Animals in our collection are members of an elite group that have adapted in order to thrive in what some may consider to be the most unforgiving ecosystem in the world: Deserts.

Animals use different modes of thermoregulation while in their native habitats through physical and behavioral adaptations. Many desert dwellers such as fennec foxes have groups of blood vessels close to the surface allowing heat to dissipate in the environment. Even though an opossum cannot sweat, they create an evaporative cooling affect by licking their fur. Adapting to the rising temperatures may even be something simple such as seeking shade and resting during periods of extreme heat.

At The Living Desert, our animal exhibits are designed to allow our collection access to plenty of shade and water to survive the summer onslaught. Exhibits and holding spaces are equipped with mister systems, swamp coolers or air conditioning.

There are even a couple species that enjoy a dip in their own pool like the African wild dogs and jaguars.

Our world-class animal care staff don't just rely on exhibit modifications to help

the collection cope. Throughout the summer, keepers work hard to give the animals something "cool" to keep them busy, usually involving ice. The giraffe occasionally enjoy a jumbo ice cube filled with produce. The mountain lion loves her blood-sicles.

When you visit the park in the summer, you may be surprised to see that not every animal takes us up on the offer for a cooler space. Some prefer their own adaptations. The Arabian Oryx, for example, prefer to dig down to cooler sand before laying down instead of using the misters that are provided.

As you are enjoying your own cool microclimate this summer, there is no reason to feel bad for the animals on exhibit at The Living Desert. Remember, they have special ways of beating the heat and thriving in the extreme climate of the Coachella Valley. Come pay them a visit!

The Best Time of Year for Tax Planning is Now

It's summer time, and local business owners are dealing with slow-downs while many families are on vacation or spending time away from the desert heat. No one feels like talking about taxes and the IRS.

The truth is that now is the best time to do your tax planning for the remainder of 2015.

Good tax planning happens as part of your yearly cycle, and is much more effective when you have time to implement a new cash flow plan or research an equipment purchase that will help grow your business and reduce your tax bill. Starting now is beneficial, instead of waiting until the end of the year and panicking, or even worse, discovering in April that you have a huge tax bill, and you have very few options to lower it at that point.

For businesses, having your tax professional review your financials mid-year can give you a number of tax-saving options. It might be time to set up a defined benefit pension plan, which can be a large deduction for your business as well as a way to set money aside for yourself. If you need to purchase equipment, Section 179 depreciation can drastically reduce your tax bill.

Another important item that needs to be addressed mid-year is shareholder salary. 401k deferrals must be made as payroll is paid out, and if this is not planned for, you may owe a big payroll tax bill if you wait until the end of the year to cover those deferrals. Additionally, the IRS continues to threaten to audit S-corporations for "reasonable salary"— an

unfavorable decision could result in a big bill if the IRS decides all owner draws should be subject to payroll taxes.

For individuals, it is time to take a look at your investment income. The new Net Investment Income Tax adds an additional 3.8% to your tax bill on investment income if your income exceeds \$250,000 for married filers. Investment gains include interest, dividends, capital gains, rental income, and many other passive activities.

Another tax deduction that needs careful planning is charitable giving. Appreciated property, which would otherwise cause a large taxable gain, can be donated for a deduction. Charitable donations over \$5,000 must be carefully planned and require an appraisal. There are several creative ways to donate property and still retain some income flows from it, such as a Charitable Remainder Annuity Trust.

Give Your Teeth a 'Facial' 5 Easy Steps

Try a Tee-cial = Teeth + Facial: a mouth (teeth/gums) care regimen that is similar to a facial but instead done for your teeth. You can do a Tee-cial once a week as an added bonus to your everyday teeth care routine.

5 STEPS - TEE-CIAL

- **1. Cleanse** It is recommended to clean the teeth for two minutes with an electric toothbrush instead of manual because it does a better job of removing plaque and fighting gum disease.
- 2. Exfoliate Give your teeth a "scrub a dub dub" by eating a few slices of crunchy foods. Apples, raw carrots, celery, and cucumbers are great options. 
